ITINERARY

We will go southwest along Provincial Route 86, enjoying the landscapes of Cacheuta until we cross the tunnel that connects this town with Potrerillos. We will contemplate the wonderful view of the majestic Cordón del Plata, Mendoza's main source of water, and the picturesque Potrerillos Dam, a mirror of crystal clear water in the middle of mountains. Then, we will make a strategic stop to get a better view of the Valley as a whole. Once we return to the route, we prepare for the highlight of the departure: The Aconcagua Provincial Park. There we will obtain the corresponding permits to make a walk of approximately one hour, which will allow us to experience the majesty of the highest hill in America from the viewpoint of the Laguna de Horcones, within the Park. Back in the van, we will move a few kilometers, until we reach the "Puente del Inca".

Duration: 9 hours approximately.
Departure time: From 08:00 am with approximate return at 5:00 pm.
Does not include entrance to the Aconcagua park.
